Item no. 4 - Bidder's Question regarding DVBE requirements due at Bid time:

1. Outreach Certification (Section 00630)

- a. Part III requests that we list all subcontractors who responded to our advertisements. Does this mean all subcontractors who provided quotes?

SFUSD Response: **This means whoever responded, regardless of whether or not they are included in your bid.**

- 2. Prime Bidder Certification of DVBE Participation (DVBE Participation Goal Policy (Section 00470, Page 3) indicates DVBE Worksheets must be submitted to the District no later than 5:00p.m. of the third working day after the opening of Bid Proposals.) -

SFUSD Response: **The District's Instructions to Bidders prevails over the DVBE form. All documentation regarding DVBE outreach must be submitted at the time of the bid. The precedent has been set since all other bidders have complied with the submittal of this documentation on bid day. If on bid day your bid does not have the required documentation, your bid may be deemed non-responsive, and/or given the shortened protest period of 5:00pm on the second business day after bid opening, a bid protest against your bid citing the lack of documentation could be deemed to have merit.**

- a. Part III requests that we list all DVBE participation, as well as all Non-DVBE participation, with dollar values for base bid and alternates 1-5.

SFUSD Response: **Please note Item B. of Part III. which provides: *List all of your DVBE subcontractors/suppliers. Enter in the appropriate column the dollar about for each of your subcontractors/suppliers.***

Item C. of Part III asks only for the total dollar amount for non-DVBE subcontractors/suppliers.

- 2. Prime Bidder Good Faith Effort Worksheet (DVBE Participation Goal Policy (Section 00470, Page 3) indicates DVBE Worksheets must be submitted to the District no later than 5:00p.m. of the third working day after the opening of Bid Proposals.)

SFUSD Response: **Please see my response to Item 2. of your request for information.**

- a. Part III requests that we list all DVBE subcontractors who submitted quotes, whether or not they were selected, as well as reasons for not selecting them.

SFUSD Response: **Please complete this form to the best of your ability.**

Please advise if it will be acceptable to submit the above items to the District no later than 5:00 PM of the third working day after the opening of the proposals.

SFUSD Response: It will not be acceptable for the District to receive these items at the time you request. Late submittal of these documents would render your bid non-responsive.

The District's requires that bidders do their best to achieve the 3% DVBE participation goal or, if they cannot do so, fully document their good faith efforts in an attempt to achieve that goal. The District's Outreach Certification (Section 630) is the second form of subcontractor outreach that the District requires to make sure that bidders are as inclusive in soliciting subcontractors/supplier quotes as possible. We fully expect both forms of outreach are achieved in order to make your bid responsive on bid day.
