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## **Middle school students showcase STEAM projects; 16th annual Youth Summit empowers students**

*Highlights for March 18 - March 22, 2019*

More than 150 students at **Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Academic Middle School** will show what it looks like to combine **Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math (STEAM) for the 4th annual STEAM Night**. During two 35 to 40 minute rotations, students will share their work from project-based learning through a **podcast and video exhibition, student-authored children's books, original musical instruments to teach the science of sound, an obstacle course, and original choreographed dance performances**. Students will answer questions about their projects and the process of their learning. The event is an opportunity for students to showcase their work and share their student voices.
