NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the above-named California School District, acting by and through its Board of Education, hereinafter "the District" will receive up to, but not after the above-stated date and time, sealed Bid Proposals for the Contract for the Work of the Project generally described as: **Junipero Serra Elementary School Modernization and Addition, PROJECT NO: 11525**

1. The Project. The Project is generally described as:
General School Modernization and construction including ADA Access and Fire/Life-Safety upgrades, including but not limited to:
New Multipurpose Building (approximately 1500 sq ft).
Existing Building Modernization including new building envelope, roof, windows, fire protection and fire alarm systems, warming kitchen, new interior finishes, new doors and hardware, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and wheel chair lift. Re-configuration of administration spaces, library, classrooms, computer lab, and warming kitchen.
Exterior site work including new retaining walls requiring engineered shoring plans, ramps, lighting, paving, utilities, gates and fencing, slurry and striping, and exterior painting.
The Work also includes hazardous material abatement as described and specified in Appendix A of the Contract Documents.
The Estimated construction value of the work is **\$6,800,000.**

2. Project Labor Agreement: All Bidders are hereby notified that the District has a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) in effect on the Project and all contractors and subcontractors bidding this project will be required to comply with the PLA.

3. Submittal of Bid Proposals. All Bid Proposals shall be submitted on forms furnished by the District. Bid Proposals must conform with, and be responsive to, the Bid and Contract Documents, copies of which may be obtained from the District as set forth above. Only Bid Proposals submitted to the District prior to the date and time set forth above for the public opening and reading of Bid Proposals shall be considered.

4. Bid and Contract Documents. The Bid and Contract Documents are available at the location stated above during standard working hours (8:00AM-4:30PM) for a **non-refundable** payment of **One Hundred Dollars (\$100)** per set. 5. Documents Accompanying Bid Proposal. Each Bid Proposal shall be accompanied by: (a) the required Bid Bond Security; (b) Subcontractors List; (c) Non-Collusion Affidavit; and (d) Statement of Bidder's Qualifications and all other items as described in the instructions to Bidder. All information or responses of a Bidder in its Bid Proposal and other documents accompanying the Bid Proposal shall be complete, accurate and true; incomplete, inaccurate or untrue responses or information provided therein by a Bidder shall be grounds for the District to reject such Bidder's Bid Proposal for non-responsiveness.

6. Prevailing Wage Rates. Pursuant to California Labor Code § 1773, the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of California has determined the generally prevailing rates of wages in the locality in which the Work is to be performed. Copies of these determinations, entitled "A PREVAILING WAGE SCALE" is maintained at the District's Labor Compliance Program, and are available to any interested party upon request. The Contractor

awarded the Contract for the Work shall post a copy of all applicable prevailing wage rates for the Work at conspicuous locations at the Site of the Work. The Contractor and all Subcontractors performing any portion of the Work shall pay not less than the applicable prevailing wage rate for the classification of labor provided by their respective workers in prosecution and execution of the Work. This project is subject to the provisions of the Labor Compliance Program adopted by the San Francisco Unified School District.

7. Labor Compliance Software: The District requires the Contractor to use a Labor Compliance Software, Elation Systems, Inc. for the duration of the Project. See section 00350 for the cost of this software. This cost is incurred by the General Contractor on behalf of the General Contractor and all the Subcontractors using the program for the duration of the project. **This cost is to be included in the Total Base Bid amount on the Bid Form.** For more information about the software, please visit web site <http://www.elationsys.com/elationsys/index.htm> or contact Elation Systems at (925) 924-0340 extension 503, or support@elationsystems.com.

8. Contractor's License Classification. In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code § 3300, the District requires that Bidders possess the following classification(s) of California Contractors License at the time that the Bid Proposals are opened: **Class B, General Contractor with Asbestos and Lead Certification or Sub-Contractor with Asbestos and Lead Certification performing the work.** Any Bidder not so duly and properly licensed shall be subject to all penalties imposed by law.

9. Bid Security. Each Bid Proposal shall be accompanied by Bid Security in an amount not less than **ten percent (10%)** of the maximum amount of the Bid Proposal, inclusive of any additive Alternate Bid Item(s). Failure of any Bid Proposal to be accompanied by Bid Security in the form and in the amount required shall render such Bid Proposal to be non-responsive and rejected by the District.

10. No Withdrawal of Bid Proposals. Bid Proposals shall not be withdrawn by any Bidder for a period of ninety (90) days after the opening of Bid Proposals. During this time, all Bidders shall guarantee prices quoted in their respective Bid Proposals.

11. Job-Walks. The District will conduct a **MANDATORY** job walk as set forth herein. There will be two job walks as indicated below. Attendance at **one** of the job walks is a requirement to bid for General Contractors. All attendees are required to sign-in to be acknowledged to be in attendance and eligible to bid. The job walk schedule will be as follows:

Bidders shall meet at **Junipero Serra Elementary School, 625 Holly Park Circle, San Francisco, CA** at the date and time for the Job Walk. Bidders shall meet directly in front of the main entrance along **Holly Park Circle**.

12. Waiver of Irregularities. The District reserves the right to reject any or all Bid Proposals or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any Bid Proposal or in the bidding.

13. DVBE Participation Goal. The District has promulgated a Disabled Veteran Business

Enterprise (“DVBE”) Participation Goal Program (“the DVBE Program”) which establishes a three percent (3%) Participation Goal for DVBEs. All Bidders are required by the District, pursuant to the DVBE Program, to submit DVBE Worksheets that confirm two (2) advertisements were published at least 14 days prior to bid opening.

14. Equal Opportunity. The San Francisco Unified School District is an “Equal Opportunity” employer and requires that, if subcontractors are used, reasonable, good-faith outreach efforts be made to all subcontractor enterprises in the local community including African-Americans, Caucasians, Hispanics, Asians, Women and others without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex or natural origin. We encourage employing residents of the community where the Project is located.

15. Award of Contract. The Contract for the Work, if awarded, will be by action of the District’s Board of Education to the responsible Bidder submitting the **lowest priced responsive Total Base Bid Proposal**. The District reserves the right to reject any or all Bid Proposals or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any Bid Proposal or in the bidding.
