The **SFUSD-CCSF Summer Institute for Tomorrow's Educators** will provide paid on-the-job training and City College San Francisco units at no cost to you. Students will attend classes at CCSF, complete paid 120 hours working with children in San Francisco summer youth programs.

Two Options

CDEV 75 High School Supervised Field Experience (3)

Supervised fieldwork in high school or middle school classrooms. Lab hours in SFUSD classrooms will be combined with lectures covering observation, evaluation and curriculum planning strategies, Common Core standards, adult roles and the student-learner. This course fulfills the pre-admissions field experience requirement for CSU credential programs.

CDEV 78 Supervised Field Experience in Community Youth Organizations (3)

Supervised work experience in youth-serving agencies to make connections between theory and practice. Observation and evaluation of school-age children and youth, planning of group activities, and the role of adults in youth programs will be examined in this course. This course fulfills the requirement for the Community Youth Worker Certificate.
