NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the above-named California School District, acting by and through its Board of Education, hereinafter "the District" will receive up to, but not later than the above-stated date and time, sealed Bid Proposals for the Contract for the Work of the Project generally described as: **Prop 39 Pkg 1A at Mission Ed Center/Kate Kennedy, Project no. 11872, and Rooftop Mayeda Campus, Project no. 11873. CCTV Camera Surveillance at Rooftop Mayeda Campus, Project no. 11946.**

1. The Project. The Project is generally described as:
The Prop 39 Energy Measures project consists of the removal and replacement of all interior and exterior lighting fixtures with new LED fixtures. Also includes the installation of lighting controls with occupancy sensors. The CCTV camera project consists of the installation of a new CCTV camera surveillance system including power supply, cabling, conduit, and hardware. The estimated construction value of the Work is **\$500,000.00.**

2. Submittal of Bid Proposals. All Bid Proposals shall be submitted on forms

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furnished by the District. Bid Proposals must conform with, and be responsive to, the Bid and Contract Documents, copies of which may be obtained from the District as set forth above. Only Bid Proposals submitted to the District prior to the date and time set forth above for the public opening and reading of Bid Proposals shall be considered.

3. Bid and Contract Documents. The Bid and Contract Documents are available at the location stated above during standard working hours (8:00AM-4:30PM) for a **non-refundable** fee per set. Checks are to be made payable **ARC Northern California**. Bidder is responsible for all shipping and handling fees. 4. Documents Accompanying Bid Proposal. Each Bid Proposal shall be accompanied by: (a) the required Bid Bond Security; (b) Subcontractors List; (c) Non-Collusion Affidavit; and (d) Statement of Bidder's Qualifications and all other items as described in the instructions to Bidder. All information or responses of a Bidder in its Bid Proposal and other documents accompanying the Bid Proposal shall be complete, accurate and true; incomplete, inaccurate or untrue responses or information provided therein by a Bidder shall be grounds for the District to reject such Bidder's Bid Proposal for non-responsiveness.

5. Prevailing Wage Rates. Pursuant to California Labor Code § 1773, the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of California has determined the generally prevailing rates of wages in the locality in which the Work is to be performed. Copies of these determinations, entitled "A PREVAILING WAGE SCALE" is maintained at the District's Labor Compliance Program, and are available to any interested party upon request. The Contractor awarded the Contract for the Work shall post a copy of all applicable prevailing wage rates for the Work at conspicuous locations at the Site of the Work. The Contractor and all Subcontractors performing any portion of the Work shall pay not less than the applicable prevailing wage rate for the classification of labor provided by their respective workers in

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prosecution and execution of the Work. This project is subject to the provisions of the Labor Compliance Program adopted by the San Francisco Unified School District.

6. Labor Compliance Software: The District requires the Contractor to use a Labor Compliance Software, Elation Systems, Inc from the duration of the Project. This cost is to be included in the Total Base Bid amount on the Bid Form, section 00400. For more information about the Elation Systems, Inc. software, its cost, and further inquiries, please visit www.elationsys.com.

7. Contractors License Classification. In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code § 3300, the District requires that Bidders possess the following classification(s) of California Contractors License at the time that the Bid Proposals are opened: **Class B, General Contractor with Asbestos and Lead Certification or Class C10, Electrical Contractor with Asbestos and Lead Certification or Sub-Contractor with Asbestos and Lead Certification performing the Work.** Any Bidder not so duly and properly licensed shall be subject to all penalties imposed by law.

8. Bid Security. Each Bid Proposal shall be accompanied by Bid Security in an amount not less than **ten percent (10%)** of the maximum amount of the Bid Proposal, inclusive of any additive Alternate Bid Item(s). Failure of any Bid Proposal to be accompanied by Bid Security in the form and in the amount required shall render such Bid Proposal to be non-responsive and rejected by the District.

9. No Withdrawal of Bid Proposals. Bid Proposals shall not be withdrawn by any Bidder for a period of ninety (90) days after the opening of Bid Proposals. During this time, all Bidders shall guarantee prices quoted in their respective Bid Proposals.

10. Job-Walks. The District will conduct a **MANDATORY** job walk as set forth herein. There will be one job walk as indicated below. Attendance at the job walk is a requirement to bid for General Contractors. All attendees are required to sign-in at each school site to be acknowledged to be in attendance and eligible to bid. The job walk schedule will be as follows:

Job Walk No: 1: Tuesday, March 7, 2017, 3:00 p.m.

Bidders shall meet first at **Rooftop Mayeda Campus, 500 Corbett Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94114** and follow afterward at **Mission Ed Center, 1670 Noe Street, San Francisco, CA 94131** at the date and time for the Job Walk. Bidders shall meet directly in front of the main entrance at each school site.

11. Waiver of Irregularities. The District reserves the right to reject any or all Bid Proposals or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any Bid Proposal or in the bidding.

12. DVBE Participation Goal. The District has promulgated a Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (“DVBE”) Participation Goal Program (“the DVBE Program”) which establishes a three percent (3%) Participation Goal for DVBEs. All Bidders are required by the District, pursuant to the DVBE Program, to submit DVBE Worksheets that confirm two (2) advertisements were published at least 14 days prior to bid opening.

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13. Equal Opportunity. The San Francisco Unified School District is an “Equal Opportunity” employer and requires that, if subcontractors are used, reasonable, good-faith outreach efforts be made to all subcontractor enterprises in the local community including African-Americans, Caucasians, Hispanics, Asians, Women and others without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex or natural origin. We encourage employing residents of the community where the Project is located.

14. Award of Contract. The Contract for the Work, if awarded, will be by action of the District's Board of Education to the responsible Bidder submitting the **lowest priced responsive Total Base Bid Proposal**. The District reserves the right to reject any or all Bid Proposals or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any Bid Proposal or in the bidding.
