
Recommendation 1: A Move Towards Equitable Day Schedule





With 20% of students of target minority groups impacted






Recommendation 2: Site Support for Bilingual and ELL Students and Community


This recommendation is voiced most loudly by 3 target groups, ELL, Southeast Asian and Samoan, and Native American students













There exists a near unilateral desire for increased opportunities for student voice and input into school planning. Across school sites, zip codes and target ethnicities.





Recommendation 4: Actively Enrich Inclusivity in School Sites and Community




- Focus groups vocalized the continued need to continue to hiring staff and personnel to mirror the diversity present in San Francisco
- This recommendation aligns with other district's LCAP priorities, such as Berkeley's, San Diego's, and Sacramento's Unified School Districts










The wide variance of opinion by site expresses a need for universal admin conversations in interests of equity of the arts.




