



**SERVICE GUIDELINES FOR GENERAL EDUCATION: FULL IMPLEMENTATION BY 2013-14 SY
(DEVELOPED DURING THE 2010-11 SCHOOL YEAR)**

Goals:

- Change routes so services support the Board of Education’s strategic plan commitments; and
- Reduce services to minimize the use of general fund budget contributions for transportation.

Assumptions about Service Reductions

1. Middle school feeder patterns will be established and will require limited transportation.
2. After school services will require limited transportation.
3. Bell times may need to change to support the strategic use of limited buses.

MIDDLE SCHOOLS

Provide limited transportation for middle school students in cases where an elementary school feeding into a middle school is not reasonably accessible to the middle school, taking into account factors including the availability of reasonable MUNI routes as well as funding for transportation.

The following is a list of the types of questions we will explore as we work to develop middle school transportation services:

- Is the distance between the elementary and the middle school more than 3.5 miles on MUNI?
- Does the MUNI trip include a transfer?
- Is the MUNI travel time more than 35 minutes?
- How would the trip time on an SFUSD school bus compare to the MUNI trip time?
- Would adjusting middle school start times: reduce transportation costs, and/or; allow SFUSD to include stops beyond the stops at elementary schools, and/or ; reduce the timeframe between when the bus arrives and instruction begins?
