It is extremely important to have this information as accurate as possible in case of injury or illness.

Applications are available in English, Chinese, and Spanish. All students should complete a new 2009/2010 application. Siblings must complete a separate application. Please be sure to use UPPERCASE letters and BLACK pen. Application must be legible. If you are not interested in the program, parent must complete student's name, write "NOT INTERESTED", and sign & date application. New applications must be filed and approved by 9/28/09 to ensure that eligibility status is not interrupted. If your application is filed late, you will have to pay for your lunch until approval is received from Student Nutrition Services. Application processing takes approximately 2-3 weeks. You will be notified via your registry as to whether or not you qualify.
