Resolution Opposing SFUSD Reduction in WSF Funding of AP Preparation Periods for 2009 – 2010 Site Budget

WHEREAS, The School Site Council of Lowell High School (SSC) is an elected body composed of Administrators, Teachers, Students, Parents and Community Members of Lowell High School, and,

WHEREAS, Each year the SSC has the responsibility of recommending a budget based on the Weighted Student Formula (WSF) funding provided to the school by the administrators at the San Francisco Unified School District who have the responsibility to allocate district funding among district school sites in accordance with established laws, regulations, and contractual provisions in place, and,

WHEREAS, The contract between the SFUSD and the United Educators of San Francisco has for many years provided a formula for determining the funding for AP Preparation periods,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, That the SSC of Lowell High School hereby requests an explanation from the SFUSD as to why the procedures, policies and formula utilized in previous years to determine funding for AP Preparation periods has not been followed for the 2009 -- 2010 school year for Lowell High School WSF funding, and,

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, That the SSC of Lowell High School *urges* the SFUSD to abide by the contract provision with the United Educators of San Francisco and the established past practices as to the funding of AP Preparation periods for the allocation of WSF funding for the 2009 – 2010 school year for Lowell High School.
